On behalf of the European Squash Federation ("ESF") and the Hungarian Squash Federation we are very pleased to invite your national teams to participate in the 2007 European U15/U17 European Junior Team Championships ("the Event").

TIMETABLE

24 February 2007	Closing Date for Entries Deadline for Payment of Entry Fee to ESF (€120 per Team). Deadline for Payment of 25% package costs to host (€324 per Team based on 7 people in twin/triple rooms).
24 March 2007	Deadline for notification to Host of accommodation requirements. Deadline for Payment of 75% balance of package costs to host (€971 per Team based on 7 people in twin/triple rooms). Supply the names of players in the teams in descending order of strength. Supply a photograph and a short biography of all participants.
20 April 2007	ESF Junior Seeding Panel seeds teams.
24 April 2007	Closing Date for Arrival Details.
10 May 2007	MNAs receive draw and seeding information.
24 May 2007	Arrival Day. Managers' & Coaches' meeting at 21.00 hrs in Hotel Forrás. Changes to Squad Orders must be lodged with the Championships Director by 20.00 hrs. (Changes must be lodged in writing and may be done by hand, letter or email in accordance with rule L2.)
25 May 2007	First day of Championships. Opening Ceremony – 10.00 hrs in the Squash Club.
28 May 2007	Final day of the Championships. Final Ceremony Departure Day.

ENTRIES / ENTRY FEES

Only official entry forms which are endorsed by Member National Associations will be accepted. These forms must be sent to both the European Squash Federation and the Hungarian Squash Federation.

The entry fee is € 120 per team.

The entry fee must be paid net of bank charges at the time of entry.

Closing date of the Championship: 24 February 2007

Entries must be on the official entry forms.

If more than 24 teams enter the event, the basis of acceptance shall be decided by the ESF Officers on a 'first come, first served' basis. All entries will be acknowledged and forms for hotel booking and travel information will be sent to the participating MNAs.

LATE ENTRIES & WITHDRAWALS

Late entries will be accepted until 24 March 2007. For entries received between 25 February and 24 March, late entry fees will apply as follows (in accordance with Rule A10):

Entry 60-89 days before the start date	Entry Fee doubled per team
Entry less than 60 days before the start date	Entry Fee trebled per team

Withdrawals from the Team Championship will be handled under rule A11 and the following withdrawal fees will apply (in addition to the entry fee).

Withdrawal 60 days or more before the start date	100% entry fee per team
Withdrawal 30-59 days before the start date	200% entry fee per team
Withdrawal less than 30 days before the start date	300% entry fee per team



ELIGIBILITY

Teams shall represent MNAs of the ESF, who have settled all financial obligations by the closing date of entry to the Championships and have not been prohibited from entering the Team Event under the provisions of the Code of Conduct or for any other reason. Participating nations must be Full Members. Players are eligible to represent an MNA provided they satisfy the criteria laid down in ESF Rule C3.

All players in the U15 Events shall be under the age of 15 years and all players in the U17 Events shall be under the age of 17 years on the final scheduled day of the Championships (28 May 2007).

SEEDING OF TEAMS

The ESF Seeding Panel will seed the teams in both events.

The package price is €185 per person. The package will commence with dinner on Thursday, 24 May and end with lunch on Monday, 28 May and will include all transport (Budapest Airport-Szeged, Szeged-Budapest Airport and the shuttle service between the hotels and the Squash Club); 4 nights accommodation in the hotel (accommodation in twin/triple rooms) with breakfast; and organisation costs. Additional nights are €50.00 per person in a twin/triple room per night (excluding food). A limited number of single rooms are available at an extra charge of € 30.00 per person per night. Lunches and dinners we will be served at the Squash Club.

There shall be a maximum of 7 people in a squad including reserves and officials. Extra charges will apply if a team consists of more than 7 people.

MNAs must send 25% (€47/person) of the Package Fee to the organiser by the closing date as a deposit for accommodation. The remaining 75% (€138/person) must be paid to the organiser not later than 24 March 2007. If the balance is not paid by this date, the initial 25% is forfeited and the entry shall be cancelled. Unless advised otherwise, the Host Association will assume that the MNA requires the full package for the Team for 4 nights.

All packages must be paid net of bank charges!

After receiving your entry we will ask you for your accommodation requirements.

TIME FRAME

Matches will be scheduled to commence on Friday, 25 May 2007 at 10.30 hrs.

It is proposed that the team managers' and coaches' meeting will take place in Hotel Forras at 21.00 hrs on Thursday, 24 May 2007.

The departure day will be on Monday, 28 May 2007 (after the finals ceremony).

PLAYING ORDER IN THE TEAM EVENT

The playing order of each day will be drawn at the first Managers' and Coaches' meeting. All ties will be played according to the current ESF rules.

DRAWS

The draws will be sent to participating MNAs no later than 14 days before the start date. The draws will also be published on the tournament website: www.squashclub.hu/ejc2007

REFEREES

The Host Association will ensure (through the Championships Referee) that a Referee and Marker officiate at every match in the Championship. The Host Association should provide sufficient qualified referees, but players or officials from the two competing teams in a tie may be asked to mark and referee their matches. Teams must provide markers as requested by the Championships Referee, who shall present a schedule of requirements at the Managers' Meeting prior to the start of the Event.

SQUASH BALLS

The Dunlop PRO XX ball will be used.

DRUGS

ESF and the Host Association reserve the right to implement compulsory dope testing for any player participating in the Championships. This event must be drug free. Dope testing may be carried out by the National Government.

EYE-PROTECTION

All competing players must wear approved eye guards at all time on court!

CURRENCY

The EURO is the official currency of the European Squash Federation. All payments to ESF must be made in Euro.

TEAM & SQUAD ORDER

1. MNAs must lodge with the ESF Office at least 30 days before the Start Date, by post, email or fax the names of the players in their squads in descending order of strength (keeping Boys and Girls separate). This must reflect the current form of players (e.g. past three months Junior Open and Closed results, Invitation Tournaments etc). Not more than 3 boys and 2 girls may be nominated; and only those players who have been officially nominated may play in any match. Any squad that has not been lodged correctly by the deadline may be scratched from the Team Championship at the discretion of the ESF Officers and risks being ignored for seeding purposes; and the MNA will be liable for a fine under the Code of Conduct (see Appendix E).

2. MNAs may lodge in writing (by hand, letter, email or fax) with the Championship Director three hours before the scheduled start time of the Managers Meeting on the Start Date, changes to their squad orders justified by changes in current form. Players previously nominated may only be replaced as a result of illness or injury, in which case any replacement must be of **lower** strength than all other players in the team in line with Rule L7.

3. The Championship Director will announce all nominations two hours before the scheduled start time of the Managers Meeting on the Start Date. Details shall be posted in the Tournament Office, the official hotel(s) and on the internet.

4. Any objections to a playing order or player eligibility must be lodged with the Championship Director by the scheduled start time of the Managers Meeting on the Start Date. Objections must be in writing and be justified with evidence such as recent results or rankings.

5. The CAP will scrutinise nominations and will consider any objection lodged with the Championship Director. The CAP reserves the right to amend any squad order without formal objection. Team Managers must be available during the Managers Meeting to give evidence to the CAP if required. The Team Manager will be advised immediately if his squad is subject to objection or amendment; or if he is required to justify player eligibility or playing order to the CAP. The CAP will hear his justification with the objecting manager(s) invited to be present. The decision of the CAP will be final and will be announced within 30 minutes of the end of the Managers Meeting. There is no right of appeal.

6. The squad playing order shall be adhered to throughout the Championships. Any player can be omitted from a Tie provided the others play in the order of merit approved by the CAP. Unless the Championship Director is notified otherwise in writing at least **one hour** before the scheduled start of a Tie or within 10 minutes of completion of the previous Tie (whichever is the later), Managers shall be deemed to have selected their top players. The CAP reserves the right to allow changes to player nominations after the deadline for each Tie in exceptional circumstances.

7. A Team Manager may request permission from the CAP to replace a member of his squad at any time during the Championships. Such permission will only be given if the reason is considered to be legitimate (e.g. illness or injury) and provided that the replacement player is accepted as being of **lower** strength than all members of the team previously nominated. The Championship Director will advise all Team Managers in writing if a player is being replaced. Any appeal against the decision to replace or not replace a player must be made within **two hours** to the CAP. All player privileges and facilities will be passed on to any replacement player, on arrival at the Championships, by the player being replaced and the replaced player may not rejoin his squad during the Championships. A Team Manager may, at any time during the Championships, appeal to the CAP if he has evidence that a player, in an opposing squad, is likely to compete, or has competed when unfit. If this appeal is upheld, then the player in question may not be nominated to compete in any Tie until approved by the CAP and appropriate action may be taken against the squad concerned.
